Sea Base Packing List

wear to airport:

class A uniform (shirt, belt, socks, pants or shorts, no neckerchief) - both scouts and adults underwear & socks - cotton okay sneakers wide-brimmed hat

have in pockets:

cell phone (optional) lip balm with sun protection face mask at least \$40 ID for TSA (adults 18+ only)

have in daypack, with name & phone on tag:

travel comfort kit (neck pillow, blanket & sleep mask) - provided by troop crew shirt - provided by troop swim trunks sandals mask & snorkel - provided by troop empty plastic water bottle (can't be metal) carabiner, to clip water bottle to boat rail polarized sunglasses in a case elastic band for glasses (optional) extra pair of prescription glasses, in a hard case 4 or more face masks toothbrush travel-size toothpaste in quart-size ziplock bag prescription medicine (in same ziplock if medicine is liquid, cream, paste or gel) camera, ideally in waterproof case (optional) deck of cards (optional) reading materials for plane home (optional) 1 pair socks, for trip home 1 underwear, for trip home

have in duffel bag (provided by troop) with name & phone on tag:

sleeping pad (foam okay for scouts, but adults need inflatable for comfort) sheet sleeping bag - provided by troop forehead flashlight extra batteries for flashlight 2 thin towels (thin dries faster & takes up less room) long-sleeve moisture-wicking shirt with sun protection short-sleeve moisture-wicking shirt with sun protection rain jacket or poncho troop t-shirt, for shore excursion shorts (quick drying, no denim), for shore excursion 1 underwear, for shore excursion cup or thermos if you drink coffee (optional) neoprene fin socks (optional) dive light (optional)
